1. Parish Council Notes:

- b. Gloucestershire Highways Department has announced Operation Road Rescue which has been concentrating on fixing the roads that have major damage caused by the severe weather from earlier this year. For example, 18,182 defects were repaired between 1st March 30th April. There are also a number of major road resurfacing activities planned including around Maisemeore and the A4019 Tewkesbury road, Cheltenham. Owing to an increase in fly tipping and the general misuse of the Ashchurch Road recycling site in Tewkesbury, the decision has been made by the site owners, Morrison's, to close the facility with immediate effect.
