- 1 Appointment of Chairman It was proposed by MR and seconded by JH that Lynda Remmer be elected as Chairman.
- 2 Appointment of Vice Chairman LR proposed JH as Vice Chairman and this was seconded by A Brown.
- 3 The Chairman welcomed everyone and introduced the Parish Council members to the meeting. The Chairman gave her report covering the two years since the last AGM in 2019 including thanking the many people who had helped in various ways during the pandemic, volunteer grass cutters, litter pickers, DofE award students etc. Ongoing items still include verges, ditches, road conditions, speeding, footpaths, possible housing development, supporting the church and village hall. - 8 Any Other Business:
- 8.1 A Brown asked if the Parish Council would consider funding a village hall sign this was acceptable and will be discussed at a forthcoming meeting.
- 8.2 S MacQuillan asked about speeding through the village and whether any electronic signs or alternatives could be considered. This will be discussed at a further meeting and the Highways Department will be contacted to see what is possible.
- 8.3 P Coleman asked if it was possible for all the various organisations within the village (Parish Council, Village Hall Committee, Working Men's Club, church) to get together for a "brain storming" meeting with presentations from each. We will wait to see if everything is open after June 21 before arranging this.
