

Minutes of Meeting of Forthampton Parish Council held on Thursday 17 June 2021 at 7.00pm.

- 1 Minutes of the meetings held on 15 April 2021 and the AGM held on 20 May 2021 were discussed and approved.
- 2 Village Hall Sign – This is a village hall decision as to what is required and we will help with the costs. LR will contact them.
- 3 Post Office – At present the van parks in Bishops Walk as there is a better signal. LR will contact the person responsible at Evesham to see if it is possible for the van to use the village hall broadband connection which may mean they have to invest in a different system to what is used now for security reasons.
- 4 Speeding – This ongoing problem has been investigated over the years. LR made enquiries about electronic signs to discover that street lights are required, otherwise expensive batteries. LR has contacted Highways to enquire whether a new “Forthampton” sign can be installed with “please slow down” marked on it, but no success. Also to see if the “slow” sign can be repainted by the war memorial. Enquiries will be made to see if a PCSO can occasionally be parked in the village.
- 5 Pond clearance – Fisher German have given permission for the pond by the war memorial to be cleared of brambles etc, to enable strimming to take place. This will not happen before the end of August – GB to arrange a working party.
- 6 Joint Communication Meeting – This will be arranged when conditions allow.
- 7 Any other business:
 - 7.1 LR has been in touch with Greenwoods and they would like to arrange for the Parish Council to visit in July.
