

Minutes of Meeting of Forthampton Parish Council held on Thursday 12 June 2025 at 7.45pm.

- 1 The minutes of the AGM and meeting held on 7 May 2025 were discussed and approved.
- 2 Financial Statements Year Ended March 2025: The following statements were approved and signed off by the Chairman and RFO:
 - . Annual Governance Statement
 - . Accounting Statements
 - . Exemption Certificate
- 3 Possible sewage discharges – LR/MR walked with Anabel MacKinnon to show her the problem area; after which she wrote to the Parish Council. This was read out to the meeting; after consideration the Council will compose a reply to her letter, requesting solutions and timeframes for the work to be carried out.
- 4 Planning has been refused for alterations to the barn at Dunsmore Green (owner Nick Oldham). The Council had no objections.
- 5 Highways – Ongoing problems with many potholes still unfilled. Church Lane hopes to be closed for two days from 23 June to carry out repairs.
- 6 Traffic through the village – Discussions still on signs, white gates, electronic speed signs with the possibility of a survey beforehand, fund raising etc. LR has been in contact with Bushley regarding their speeding situation. Still an ongoing problem. MR asked if we request the 30mph signs be positioned further out from their existing locations.
- 7 MP's visit (Matt Bishop) took place on 27 May with attendees listening and asking questions. He said he hoped to visit again.
- 8 Verge mowing – Carl Moss abstained from this item. It was confirmed he will cut the verges as shown on the map supplied to him by Glos CC. Mike Hook will cut the grass in the centre of the village and the Council has agreed to pay him £25 per cut. The Council will ask the Estate for a possible donation at the end of the season.
- 9 Any other business:
- 9.1 Fly tipping – JH has passed over all the necessary information on the latest occurrence, where an address was found among the builders rubble.
