

Minutes of Meeting of Forthampton Parish Council held on Thursday 11 September 2025 at 7.45pm.

- 1 The minutes of the meeting held on 10 July 2025 were discussed and approved.
- 2 Sewage discharges – A progress letter from the Estate was received which stated the work was still hoped to be completed before the year end.
- 3 Highways – Visits from Glos Highways, but nothing further done. SH has drafted a letter which will be viewed by councillors and then signed off by LR. It will be sent to Highways and TBC.
- 4.1 Traffic update – After chasing by LR, Stuart Bullen from Highways has had “rubber strips” installed on the main roads into the village which will give details of speed, weight, time etc. Results should be available at the end of the month.
- 4.2 The Council has written to “Glos 20 is Plenty Scheme” expressing our interest but stating problems, ie the main roads do not start in Gloucestershire. We have asked to be kept aware of developments.
- 5 Notice Board – Due to the deteriorating condition the Council agreed that it will be relocated in the bus shelter for protection.
- 6 Any other business:
 - 6.1 A parishioner requested further clarification regarding the Parish Council’s contribution towards the pond maintenance.
 - 6.2 The second cut of grass verges will be completed within days.
 - 6.3 A litter pick has been arranged for Saturday 1 November at 10.00am.
