- 1 Minutes of the meeting held on 20 June were discussed and approved.
- 2 Matters arising:
 - 2.1 Post Office Van – The driver does not like its current position as it is dangerous and the best location for reception is the Village Hall car park. It is hoped the van will be relocated next week.
 - 2.2 Broadband – MR has spoken to Gigaclear and it is hoped the wayleave agreements will be prepared and sent for signature next week.
 - 2.3 Green Waste – this is gradually reducing and it is hoped will not be used in future.
- 3 First Aid – The Village Hall are very keen for this to take place and LR will contact the person responsible at GCC to obtain dates, hopefully before Christmas.
- 4 Village Information Sheet – this was approved after minor amendments.
- 5 The next Fisher German meeting will take place on 12 September when footpaths will be raised.
- 6 Any Other Business:
 - 6.1 White Gates – LR will check with residents living near the church to see if they think gates are needed to slow traffic down.
 - 6.2 MR will contact the owners of the “shoot” to remind the gamekeeper of the speed limits within the village.
 - 6.3 A letter was received from Stanton Surgery and LR will contact them with dates as they would like to attend one of the council meetings.
 - 6.4 MR will contact the Highways Agency to see if they can install a sign indicating where the Lower Lode Inn is situated to avoid large caravans etc turning into wrong small roads.
 - 6.5 RR will arrange a meeting with Richard Ascough to establish blocked footpaths.
